### Visa Information

Participants may enter the U.S. on a B2 visitor visa. Visa letter will be provided.

### Accommodations

On-campus dormitory housing; two meals per day in UH cafeteria. Additional meals on own.

### Health Insurance

Required for all students. If not purchased in home country, students will be required to purchase online upon arrival in Hawai'i.

### Cost

Application Fee: \$75 (non-refundable)  
 Program Fee: \$1,525  
 Accommodations, Meal Plan, and Airport Transfer: \$1,650
